## **Course Registration & Transcript Information: Semester/Bimester**

This form is for students whose sending schools follow a schedule best described as a "semester" or "bi-mester". Additional Offerings: Honors Math, Honors Spanish or Independent Language Study (for those already taking a non-Spanish language). Students choose up to two of these courses. All students also have at least one study hall period. If the student does not need math and/or a language, they have a choice of an extra study hall period and/or OA's unique Nature Writing elective.
